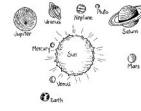

FURY in the FOOTHILLS

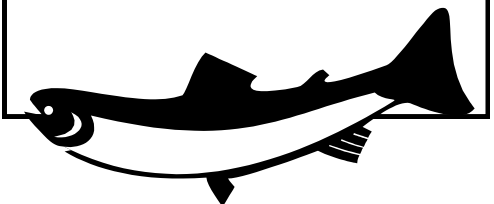
