Here are some highlights and reminders:

Open House Calendar - Visiting post-secondary campuses is one important step in preparing for further studies after high school. U of Lethbridge, U of Calgary, U of Alberta, SAIT, Bow Valley College and Mount Royal all have events this month. Check the calendar at palliseroffcampus.ca for dates, registration links and more.

Introduction to Ironworking - Are you interested in the exciting career of ironworking? Local 725 in Lethbridge is offering a 10-week program for students with a sincere interest. Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account.
The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

Step 3: Find Student

Note: Student Number is Not Required

This step will connect your children to your account.

- Enter the School Board Name
- Enter the School Name
- Enter Your Child's Name & Birth Date
- Select **Continue**
- On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select **Continue**
- Your child has been added to your account

Step 4: View Items or Add Another Student

If you have more children, select "Add Another Student" option and repeat the steps above. 5 children can be added to one parent account.
If you do not wish to add additional children, select "View Items For Students" option. A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.

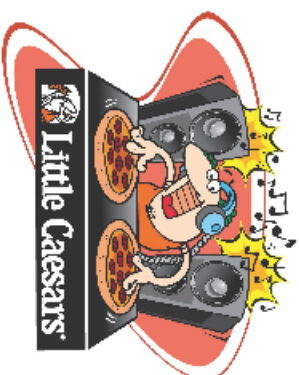

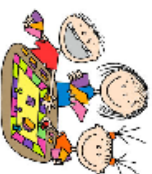
