RATIONALE:

2. Provide proof of acceptance or enrollment in a college, technical institution, registered apprenticeship program, or university.
3. Demonstrate (a) school and community involvement, (b) sportsmanship, (c) citizenship, and (d) good moral character.
4. If an applicant is in a registered apprenticeship program, funds will not be awarded until the applicant attends classes.
