

LIONS LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP

RATIONALE:

LIONS are men and women who volunteer their time to work and to raise funds for humanitarian causes around the world and in their own communities. The club has over 1.4 million members worldwide who stand for integrity, compassion and understanding.

Five Lions clubs in the county of Vulcan support youth via Legacy Scholarships. Milo club has their own award, described elsewhere in this booklet. The other four Lions clubs representing: Arrowwood, Champion, Mossleigh, and Vulcan together offer **TWO LIONS LEGACY SCHOLARSHIPS**, each valued at **\$500.00**.

If you are a grade 12 student who demonstrates a spirit of volunteerism for your school, and who lives a life that reflects the character and philosophy that the Lions are known for, you should apply for a **\$500 Lions Legacy Scholarship**.

CRITERIA:

Lions Legacy Scholarships will be awarded to students who:

1. Be a grade 12 graduate in the year in which the award is applied for, from CCHS Vulcan.
2. Have been accepted to a post-secondary institution for one or more years of study leading to a certificate or degree.
3. Submit the following items to the selection committee:
 - a. Application Form, completed.
 - b. Transcript of final Grade 12 marks.
 - c. Confirmation of acceptance at the post-secondary institution of their choice, and the specific field into which they are enrolling.
 - d. Letters of reference (maximum of four), with a detailed summary of their character, leadership roles within the school, involvement in extra-curricular activities, involvement in organizations in the community at large, work experiences, and special interests/hobbies.
 - e. One page self-written letter expressing why they should receive the award.
4. Demonstrate a commitment to humanitarian causes and exhibit the Lion's service oriented philosophy by actively volunteering in their communities.

Deadline: **August 31**

Recipients will be determined by the CCHS Award Selection Committee. There will be NO appeal of the committee's decision.

The committee is not obliged to award every available scholarship if it is felt that candidates do not satisfy the criteria.
