CHAT

CHAT stands for Community, Homework, and Tutorial

- 45 minutes each day:
 - Time to complete homework, study, and work on group projects.
 - Time to see teachers for extra help.
 - Time for classroom presentations, community building, and fostering positive relationships.

How is Junior High Different?

- Different Teachers for Each Subject
 - Students move from room to room
 - Teachers are subject-area specialists as well as middle school specialists
- Students Get Lockers
 - Safe space to store your belongings
 - Combination locks are assigned
- Report Cards
 - Progress reports (with comments) in November and April
 - Report cards in January and June
 - Marks represented in percentages
- Increased Workload
 - More time needed to complete work, study, and reading
 - Faster pace with less time to catch up if you fall behind
