Paul Liska Agricultural Scholarship

Award:

Net annual income derived from the investment of the trust fund. Currently the scholarship is approximately \$150 per year.

Criteria:

- 1. Applicant shall be entering post-secondary education at the university level.
- 2. Applicant must be pursuing a career in the sciences.
- 3. Applicant must have an acceptable academic standing permitting university entrance as determined by teacher-awarded marks.
- 4. Applicant has financial need as determined by a counsellor and/or school administration.

HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. Apply in writing to the School Principal no later than May 1st of each year.
 - a) State your qualifications and the scholarship you are applying for; and
 - b) Include proof of attendance at a post-secondary educational facility and a copy of your Grade 12 marks. If you are unable to provide this information with your application, please send the information as soon as possible.
- 2. Applicants cannot be considered for any scholarship unless all the necessary information is received.
- 3. Mail applications marked "Scholarship Application" to the School Principal.
- 4. Applications will be forwarded to the Superintendent of Schools, with the scholarship being awarded by May 1st of each year.
